We have organised a programme of activities to run throughout summer for our young people in the Minster and Woodmansey wards of Beverley, an area that sees high seasonal ASB service requests. These activities include multi-sports activities such as rugby, football, boxing, self-defence and fishing as well as Lego art and Twilight Sessions. We are also providing weekly sessions in which young people can learn about topics, such as Violence Against Women and Girls and mental health. We are working with partners and organisations to provide these sessions such as Hull FC, the Cherry Tree Centre , ERVAS, Humberside Police, the East Riding leisure centre, the Domestic Violence and Abuse Partnership and Public Health.

We are organising a one-day summer event in Beverley where we are bringing together partners and the community to provide fun activities for young people, as well as giving partners the opportunity to give the community information about their services.

To raise awareness and provide visibility we are also planning additional Police and Fire presence in the community as part of walkabout-talk about for residents
